## Day One

### **Visit: Mazza Vineyards**

Mazza Vineyards is the family's original location and flagship winery, boasting a cozy, Mediterranean charm and award-winning wines.

### **Eat: The Skunk & Goat Tavern**

The Skunk & Goat offers a unique take on the American tavern experience, with a focus on craft brews, prohibition-era inspired cocktails and eclectic dishes.

### **Visit: Arundel Cellars & Brewing Company**

Set inside a beautifully restored late 19th century barn, Arundel Cellars is a winery, brewery and cidery in one location.

### **Visit: 21 Brix Winery**

At 21 Brix, the name is inspired by the measure of sweetness in grapes. Look for Ella the bright pink elephant statue welcoming you outside the main entrance.

### **Visit: Johnson Estate Winery**

The oldest continuously operating estate winery in New York State, this third-generation winery produces award-winning wines from 13 varieties of grapes.

### **Eat: U Pick 6 Harbor House**

Experience a comfortable pub style restaurant featuring wood-fired pizzas and a variety of craft beers.
